## Saguaro View Management: 2025 Candidate Statement Dr. James D. Smith

Susan and I have been shareholders in the Saguaro View Homeowners Association since 1998. I served on the Saguaro View Management, Inc. (hereafter SVM) Board of Directors as Vice President 2001-2004, President 2019, and Director at Large 2023-2024. I am familiar with ALL of our corporate documents: 1980 Articles of Incorporation and 1997 Bylaws. Guided by the Association's attorney, I consolidated all previous amendments of our CC&Rs in the 2003 Restated Declaration of CC&Rs. I am also familiar with the "Planned Community Statutes" of the Arizona Revised Statutes as well as the "Non-Profit Corporation Act".

The duties of SVM Officers and/or Directors are:

- 1. Oversee and ensure the lawful operational integrity of our well site and water system.
- 2. Oversee the periodic maintenance and repair of our dirt roads.
- 3. Insure the rights and privileges of ALL Association shareholders within the context of our community documents and Arizona Revised Statutes.
- 4. Inform the Association shareholders of ALL actions and decisions through regularly scheduled SVM Board meetings where shareholders may interact with the Board on critical issues.

I pledge to conduct these duties in compliance with Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) § 10-3830 General Standards for Directors:

- 1. In good faith
- 2. With the care an ordinary prudent person in a like position would exercise under similar circumstances.
- 3. In a manner the director reasonably believes to be in the best interest of the corporation.

Aside from our well/water system and road maintenance and repair, the current SVM Board has:

- 1. An Executive Officer (President Holguin) who has frequently acted independently without seeking SVM Board advice and consent and has violated A.R.S. § 33-1804 Open Meetings: Exceptions at **least twice** by holding "secret meetings" (SVM Board ONLY phone conference and/or email interactions) without allowing shareholder attendance or participation.
- 2. Operated two, going on three, consecutive years WITHOUT AN APPROVED budget!
- 3. Neglected upgrading or updating the SVM website which is grossly out of date.

If re-elected to the 2025-2027 SVM Board, I pledge to correct these deficiencies and promote shareholder participation in ALL "Association" affairs including:

- 1. Quarterly updates on issues concerning our well and water system.
- 2. Quarterly scheduled road maintenance and dust control.
